

Pathway to Success Level 2 - January start

This course is designed for 16-18 year olds.

The NCFE Award for Employability Level 2 qualification will allow you to prepare for a career in the various private and public sector roles, from administration to front line customer service positions.

Learners will gain insight into the various career options available. You will learn about team building, problem solving, Health and Safety procedures and more.

You will take part in adventurous activities which relies on being resilient and a team player, all which are keys factors for developing your employability skills. With this course you will be able to be one step closer on applying for higher level course within the further education sector or an apprenticeship programme.

The course is scheduled over three days per week and will be a mixture of theory and practical lessons.

The College has strong links with the Hope in Haringey Charity, which offers mentoring positions in various career roles. The mentoring scheme will allow you to have one to one understanding of the role you are interested in and how you could achieve the desired skills to be successful within that industry.
