

Beauty Therapy Level 3

This course is suited for learners seeking to advance in their profession or to become salon managers and/or salon owners.

The VTCT Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Beauty Therapy qualification will provide you with the knowledge and skills to develop your career within the Beauty Industry.

Learners will develop their communication and customer service skills as well as practical and commercial skills, all of which are valued highly by employers.

Waltham Forest College is putting sustainability at the heart of everything that we do, and in this course, you will learn about the environment and how salons are working to become sustainable by introducing energy saving techniques, sourcing clean, vegan, ethical and eco products and by recycling. The work environment can be varied in size, style and ambiance, from a cruise ship, through to small bespoke salons or luxury high end beauty salons and spas. A beauty therapist works independently or as part of a team supported by a manager.

The entry requirements for this course are:

- Beauty Therapy Level 2 qualification

You will be required to attend an informal interview which may include completing an assessment based on your prior qualifications.

- Client care and communication in beauty related industries
- Working in beauty related industries
- Provide body massage
- Provide facial electro-therapy treatments
- Provide body electro-therapy treatments

- Continual assessment throughout the course
- Written assignments
- Written/online test
- Portfolios of collated study evidence

Practical assessments are undertaken on paying clients and must be completed in a commercially acceptable timescale.

In addition to timetabled classes there is provision for independent study time. Students will undertake independent learning, investigation and research and bring this to present and share in subsequent classes.
