UNIVERSITY

University will allow you to expand on the knowledge you have gained from your course and focus towards a specialism. Our Careers Team will assist you with your UCAS application and ensure you have all the support you need to choose the right university and degree for you.

EMPLOYMENT

By the end of your time at college you will have had opportunities to engage with employers. This could be through work experience or industry placements, talks, workshops and networking sessions. We will also help you to develop your CV and provide interview practice.

APPRENTICESHIP

An apprenticeship allows you to work 4 days a week with an employer with 1 day a week at a training provider. Some students start their post-school education at college and then progress after one year to an apprenticeship.

PROGRESS IN COLLEGE

We will support your progression through college. This could mean progressing from a Level 2 to a Level 3 course, or ensuring you get the important GCSE grade 4 pass in maths and English.

If you are studying a Level 2 course in business, construction, creative, digital, childcare or health & social care you may be able to progress onto a T Level.

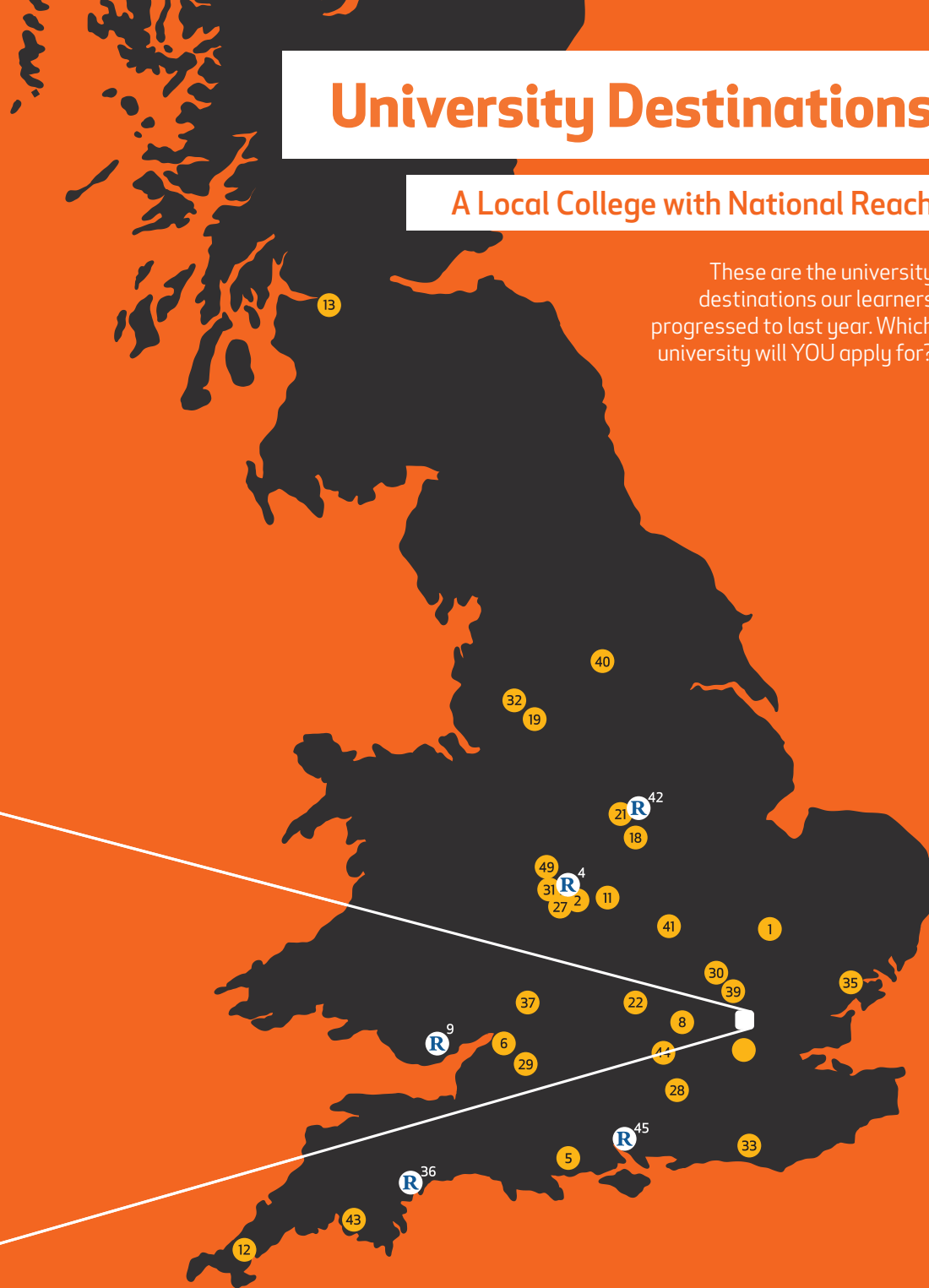

GCSEs

Waltham Forest College now delivers GCSE courses for 16-18 learners, for those who have just missed out on Grade 4s in their GCSE exams and those who have just recently entered the country.

The programme consists of a range of subjects that can be taken in combination with each other to have a complement of GCSEs that lead towards a complete package enabling progression to Level 3 study.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this study programme, students must have a minimum of Grade 3 in English (Language and/or Literature) and Mathematics.

Students must be able to demonstrate a positive attitude to their prior studies measured through a student reference and their prior attendance.

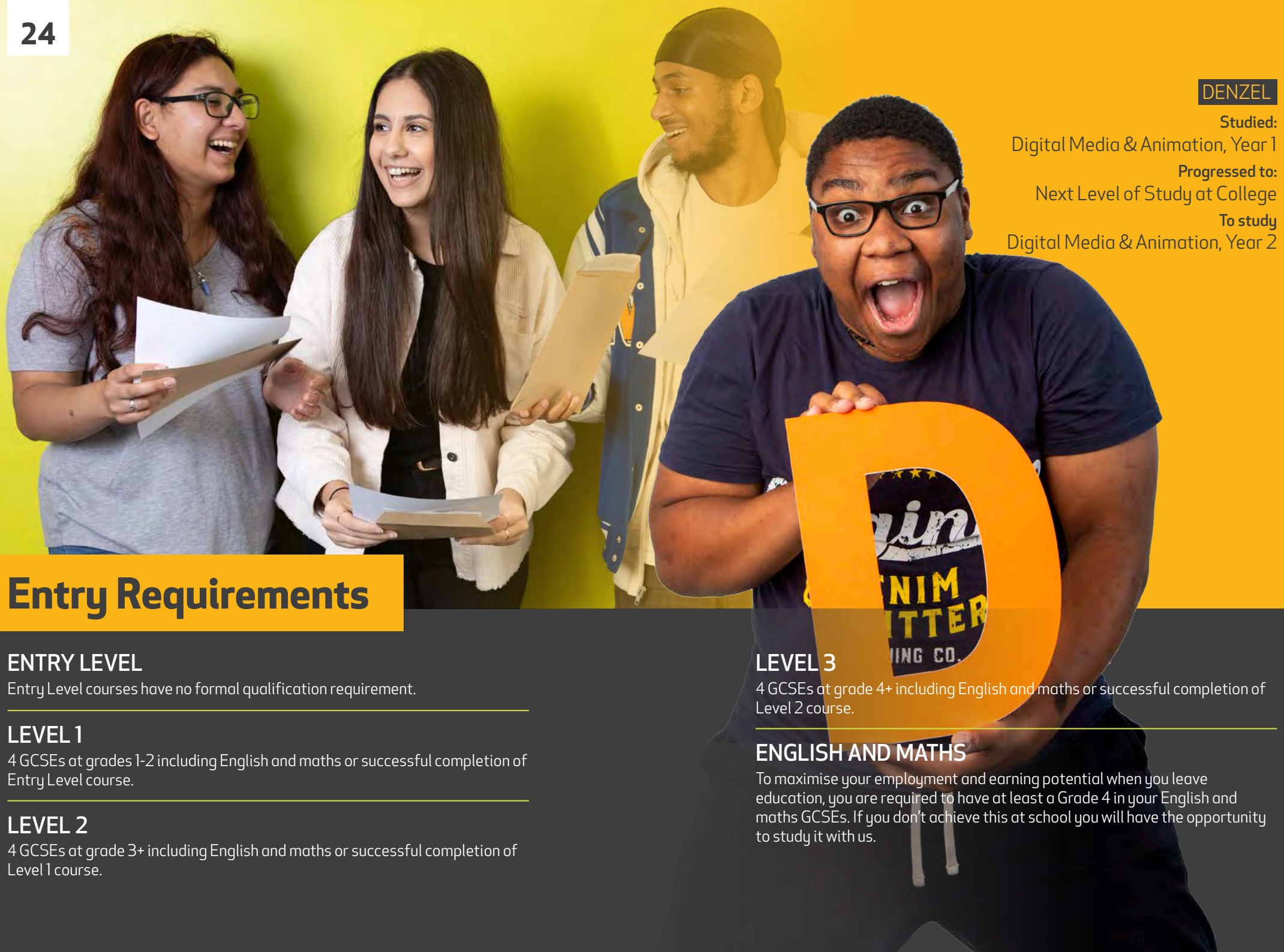

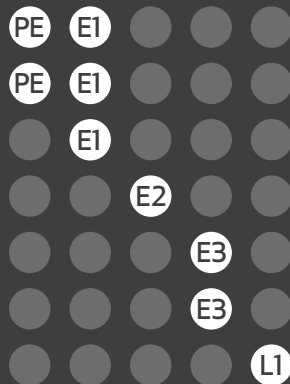

TRAIN / TUBE

Trains run to Walthamstow Central from Liverpool Street station. There is a 15 minutes walk to the College. Alternatively, you can get a bus.

Wood Street station is approximately 10 minutes walk from the College.

The Victoria Line ends at Walthamstow Central, which is approximately 15 minutes walk to the College.



BUS

From Walthamstow Central:

Bus 275 stops outside the College.

212 stops across the road from the College (Shernhall Street).

Buses 97, 357, 34 or 215 stop at the 'Bell Corner' (junction of Hoe Street and Forest Road). From here, the College is approximately 5 minutes walk.

From Blackhorse Road Tube station:

Bus 123 also stops outside the College on route between Tottenham and Ilford.
